2. Revise as follows:

2.11 **Knowing Act** Consciously initiating the powered opening of a door. Any conscious action with expected results of egress through a door. This includes but is not limited to: wall or jamb-mounted contact or non-contact switches such as push plates; the action of manual opening (pushing or pulling) a door; and controlled access devices such as keypads, card readers, wireless transmitters and keyswitches.
